Loose Cumulative Sentences Day Two

Loose/Cumulative sentence is a sentence with its **main clause at the beginning** and additional grammatical units added after it. It can convey a great deal of information and imagery. ... It accumulates extra information as it goes on. A main clause is the independent clause in a sentence with a subject and verb.

- **They slept, a sleep** deeper and more relaxing than they have dreamed possible, a **sleep** that was itself undisturbed by dreams. (appositive phrases follow the main clause)
- **The girl raised the flag**, its green striped fabric tattered and torn by bullets. (nominative absolute phrase follows the main clause)
